Our efforts in sustainable manufacturing have been recognised with not one but two Queen's Awards for Enterprise in Sustainable Development. We are also proud to have gained a Carbon Neutral+ accreditation.

From growing our own natural fillings, to designing glue free spring systems to weaving FR chemical free mattress fabric in-house, not only are we committed to using more sustainable materials in the production of our beds, but we pledge to recycle every mattress we produce that contains our Cortec[™] spring technology. With over 100,000 mattresses in the UK going to landfill each week, we want to provide a solution. In 2021 we will be opening our mattress recycling plant, where we can recycle each mattress that contains Cortec[™], making sure all the components are recycled through the appropriate channels.



Our beds are home-grown in Yorkshire



Our beds don't start life in a factory but on the Harrison Spinks 300 acre farm in North Yorkshire.

It is here that we rear sheep on rich untreated pastures and tend fertile fields of hemp and flax crops. Our hemp and flax crops produce super absorbent fibres, that help to absorb moisture from the mattress while you sleep, keeping you cool and dry.

We use zero pesticides to grow our hemp and flax. Instead these fibres are grown the way we believe they should be: naturally. This greatly lessens the impact on the environment by reducing CO2 emissions, which helps us and you rest easier.

We are proud to have partnered with British wool to ensure all the wool we use is from traceable British farms and is ethically sourced. Together it gives us complete sustainable control from sheep to sleep.



Our award-winning engineer's design and build ultra-fast spring machines in house.




We test the efficiency of all springs and mattresses in our own lab.

Microlution Airflow Springs

Comprised of a tall mini spring enclosed within a High Density (HD spring), contouring to your body with precision accuracy, reducing pressure points and keeping your spine in alignment.



HD Titanium Alloy Springs

Working completely independent from one another, their three dimensional shape means they adapt to your body's contours, relieving pressure and providing greater comfort and lumbar support.



Posturfil Springs

These flexible low-height springs are encased in breathable pockets for enhanced ventilation, reacting instantly to a sleeper's movements to provide targeted support.

Luxuriously sustainable fillings

We pride ourselves on the ingredients we use in our mattresses. For us that means sourcing the finest environmentally friendly materials and eliminating the use of foam for more sustainable options, each one helping to achieve the ideal balance of comfort and support.

Wool

Soft, springy, with temperature regulating properties to help keep you warm and dry, wool is also antibacterial and fire retardant.

Hemp

Home-grown on our farm and other local farms, with excellent sustainability credentials. Hemp is extremely absorbent and naturally resilient to mildew.

Flax

Used to make linen, flax is light, absorbent and a breathable, organic filling.

Cotton

Soft and durable, cotton has strong moisture wicking properties.

Cashmere

Known for it's supreme softness, cashmere is warm and lustrous but highly resilient.

Silk

The strongest of the natural fibres, silk has strong moisture absorbing qualities making it perfect for regulating body temperature.

Alpaca

Alpaca is luxuriously soft, containing no lanolin therefore naturally hypoallergenic.

Kapok

Otherwise known as tree silk, this light and temperature regulating fibre originates from the seed pods of a kapok tree.

Viscose

Often thought of as man-made, this fibre is derived from the wood pulp of eucalyptus, beech and pine trees. Versatile and lightweight, viscose blends perfectly with other fibres.

Egyptian Cotton

Egyptian cotton with it's super fine strands, helps to keep you cool and dry.

Mohair

Softer and smoother than wool, it's fine silky texture gives it a more luxurious feel. Mohair shares the beneficial properties of wool but with added sumptuousness.

Ecotex

A sustainable fibre that is made from 100% recyclable materials that is also fully recyclable at end of life.






